hard to imagine today. Tempers ran high at meetings, churches were packed for sermons and tracts and condemnations flew back and forth. Newman eventually joined the Catholic Church, to the desolation of his followers, though Pusev and Keble both remained within the Church of England.

Frank Buchman was an American evangelist reaching "world-changing through life-changing". As well as joint confession of sins, his Oxford group set aside a "quiet time" each day for the reception of messages from God about current events. The Group grew into the internationally influential Moral Rearmament Movement, which was thought to have Fascist sympathies. It reached its peak in the 1950s, but lost impetus with Buchanan's death in 1961.
