



The Importance of Being Earnest

The Importance of Being Earnest, at the Playhouse until Saturday, is a production with all the brilliance that Wilde's star comedy deserves. Short, sharp, and energetic, the cast breathed life, if frivolous life, into the idiosyncratic characters and farcical plot. The rather convoluted Wildean dialogue resulted in the occasional opening-night stumble, but for the most part each phrase was delivered clearly and with relish, losing none of its comedic value.



tual dialogue has been changed, including, for instance, the exchange between Lady Bracknell and Jack in which she asks him of his politics and he replies: 'I have none; I'm New Labour'. She says: 'Oh, they're really Tories, they dine with us...' But a few throwaway lines does not change the essential nature of the play. Wilde's witticisms on marriage and

society have less relevance in an age not of ideals, but of divorce and profound social change. The attempt is bold, but somehow unconvincing.

The set design, too, presents a beautifully phrased, somewhat whimsical, but ultimately rosy world. Overall, the blue skies and garden furniture were visually stunning and atmospheric, but it was the atmosphere we are accustomed to seeing in such productions: larger than life, camp.

comedic potential of the play to its utmost, drawing out the contrasts between country and town in the two butlers and two women with many a visual. Particularly charming was the pink light bloomed in the 'clouds' above Algernon and Cecily's first kiss. Every gesture, from Algernon's tearing-up of his mail to Lady Bracknell's inching towards Jack as he explains how much money he has, have been weighed and interpreted for maximum impact. The cameraderie between the two men is passed over in favour of sharpening their volleys of wit to frustration for Jack and insouciance for Algernon, but although this considerably weakens the fraternal ending, it serves as a funny and thorough introduction to the characters. The actors came through with quality performances; in particular, Jess Brooks's Cecilv was acted with precision and panache, and Susan Hitch's Lady Bracknell was both formidable and flighty.

Though the programme hints at the production's engagement with the dark undertones of the play, the 'coded' homosexual references and political content, little if any darker comment is evident onstage. The play has

The history of Earnest has largely been that of a 'period' drama, specific to the drawingroom, the fin-de-siecle, and it has weathered well. It still gets laughs from its audiences that can drown out the next dose of champagne wit, and it still benefits from the force of its author's personality. To try and make it newly 'relevant' is a mistake, unless one is prepared to be drastic: the plight of lovers crossed from marriage by disapproving elders is something that the modern audience overall, enjoys in retrospect: A Midsummer Night's Dream, or Jane Austen. It doesn't mesh well with the overarching concept of Wilde in business suits with mobile phones. The production stands on its own as a well-acted and entertaining evening; the modernization is too minor to make a true statement, and too major to be entirely harmonious.
